**Skin:** If contact with molten wax, cool wax immediately, but do not remove from skin. Seek medical attention.

**Inhalation:** Remove to fresh air. If breathing becomes difficult, seek medical attention.

**Ingestion:** If small amounts are ingested it will pass the system undigested.

**Section 5 - Fire Fighting Measures**

There is no explosion hazard from these materials under normal circumstances. However, use of water on molten Wax may cause an explosion.

**Extinguishing Media:** Dry chemical, foam, carbon dioxide. Do not use water on a wax fire.
